On Saturday, October 24, 2009 thousands of events across the planet will engage ordinary people in the International Day of Climate Action called 350. Here in Albuquerque several events highlight the day with the first being a 3.50 Mile Healing Walk for Earth sponsored by NM Interfaith Power and Light and friends.

Beginning at 8:00 am at the Bosque School, 4000 Learning Rd. NW with registration followed by an opening ceremony engaging people of various faith traditions in sharing how walking is part of their transformative spiritual path, walkers will pray, meditate, send healing energy for the planet as they contemplate next steps in reducing their carbon footprints.

350.org, a national grassroots effort is encouraging the events to highlight the number 350 as the most important number on the planet. 350 stands for 350 parts per million of carbon dioxide for optimal life and balance on Earth. Today, with climate change, we are at 390 ppm.

Everyone is invited to the morning healing walk. Postcards will be available to sign for President Obama to call for a strong US stance at the International Climate Change meeting in Copenhagen in December and t-shirts will be available for a small donation.
